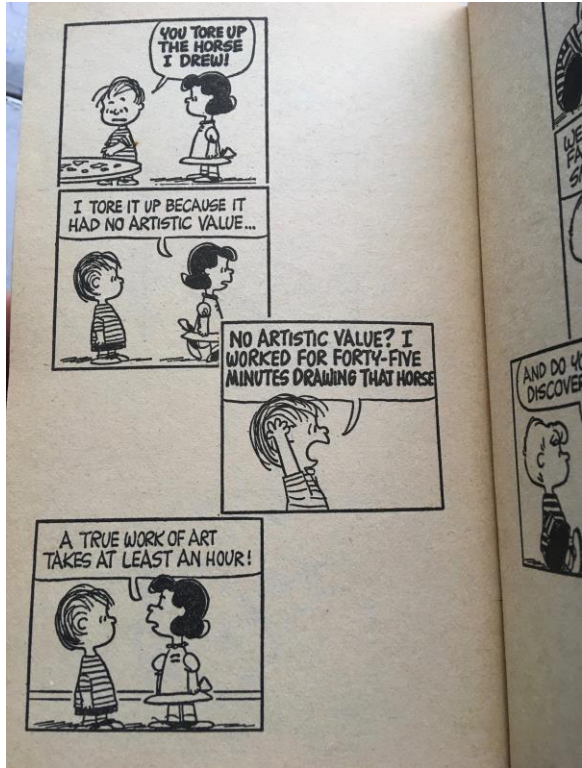

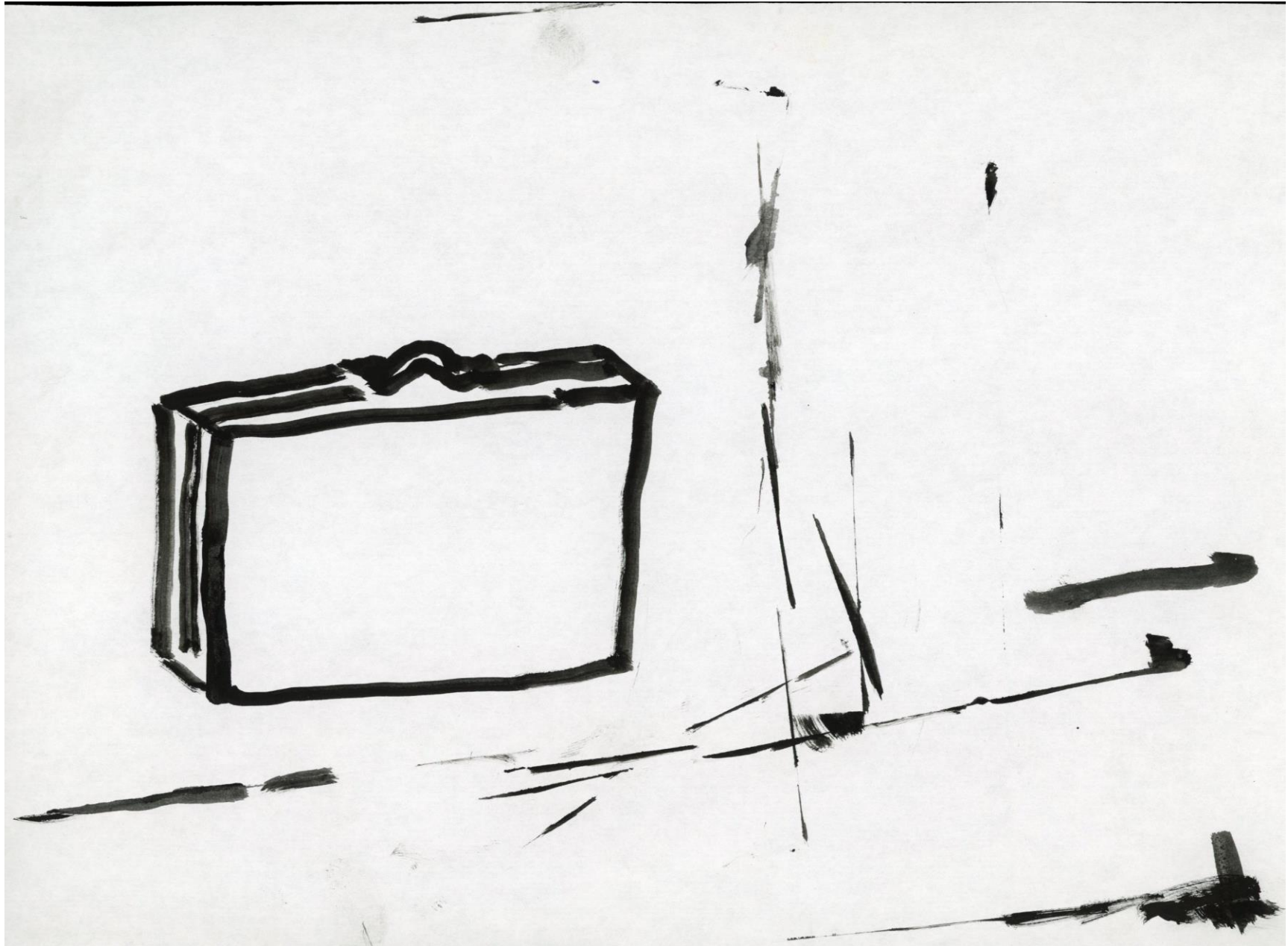


## (1) A Drawing

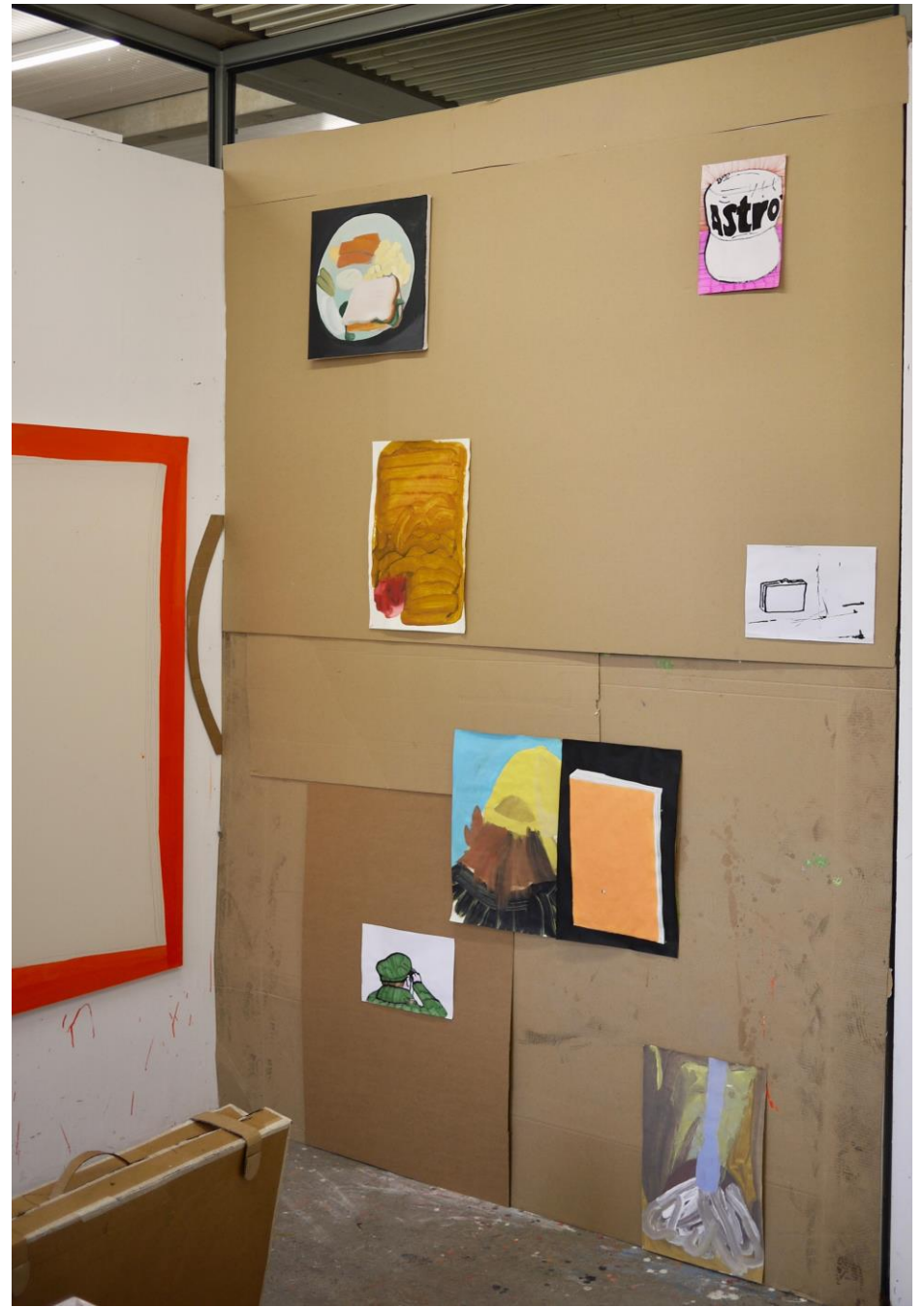

## (6) A presentation

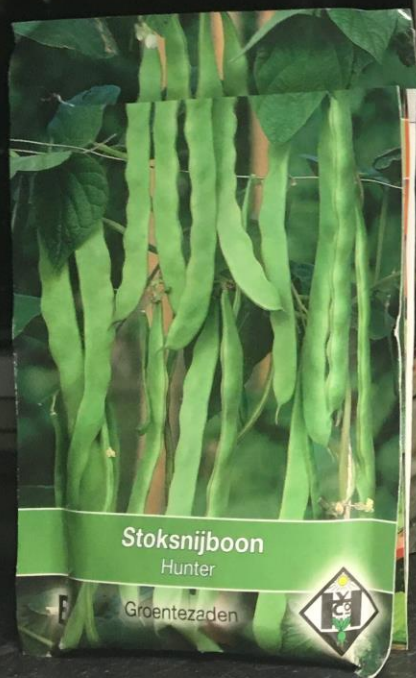

Amstel park.





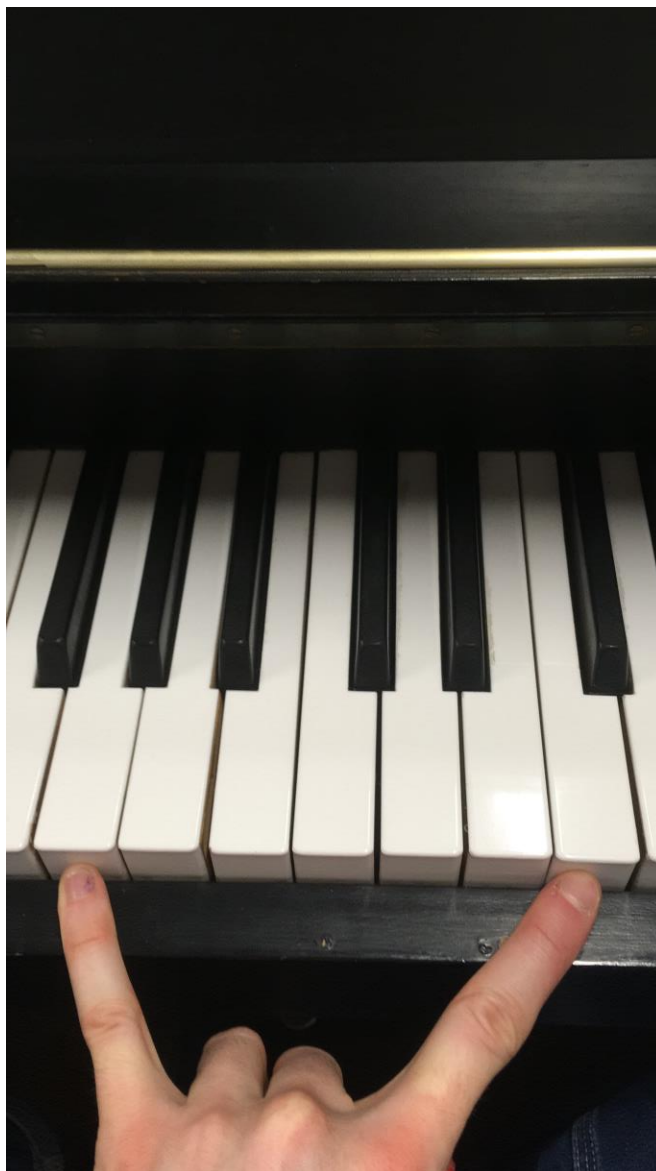
## (8) A Flop
